Plans Underway for New Resident Activity Space

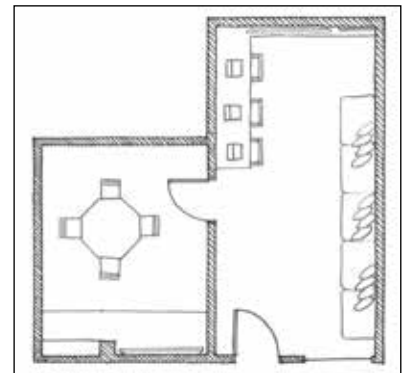

Maybe get together with other neighbors for a rousing game of bridge. Perhaps play tic-tac-toe with their grandchildren on the chalk board that fills an entire wall. Maybe check their email with the help of family members or staff or maybe host private family get-togethers. Picture a rec room designed just for older adults.

These ideas will hopefully come to life later this year on the first floor of Providence Mount St. Vincent across from the gift shop. Currently residents and TCU patients do not have a comfortable private space in which they can be with their family or friends. Thanks to generous donors who support the Providence Mount St. Vincent Foundation, partial funding is available to refurbish this space.

This new space already has a name: “Moe’s Place.” It is being named in loving memory of Maureen Romano who lived at The Mount for more than 30 years following a tragic hiking accident when she was in her 20s. In spite of her challenges, she was a life force for all who came to know and love her. Maureen loved parties and getting together with our family and friends as well as attending concerts and special events away from The Mount. Despite her situation, she truly believed in “joie de vivre” (joy of living).

Maureen’s family visited often and hosted many parties throughout the years. “While everyone at The Mount always made us feel welcome and at home, a place for our family to gather with Maureen would have been lovely,” notes Anne Romano Sarewitz, Maureen’s sister. “I’m so glad residents will have a new space to gather, and our

Chapel Named for William Pigott

On April 26, 1924 — the Sisters of Providence dedicated “St. Vincent Home for the Aged” as a result of a committed partnership between the Sisters and local Seattleites who shared in the dream of providing a home for older adults in need of care. Exactly 91 years later on April 26, Providence Mount St. Vincent celebrated this commitment with a special Mass to honor one of the founders of The Mount, William Pigott, and the Sisters of Providence. The Mount named its Chapel the “William Pigott Chapel” in honor of Mr. Pigott to commemorate his visionary commitment to the Sisters of Providence, his legacy of faith, service and sacrificial giving and to honor the continued generosity of his granddaughter, Mrs. Ann Pigott Wyckoff, and the Pigott and Wyckoff family.



The Mass opened with “Ave Maria” sung by Julia Sarewitz, relative of several former Mount residents. Sister Lucille Dean, SP, welcomed the standing room only group of guests by sharing historical information about how the Sisters of Providence first came to Seattle and how

their tradition of partnering with the community helped them achieve their mission of serving the poor.

One such partner was William Pigott, a business leader who launched the steel industry here. Mr. Pigott played a crucial role in generating support to help the Sisters build Providence Mount St. Vincent. This dedication and spirit has flowed from generation to generation and has been a part of his granddaughter’s life forever. Mrs. Wyckoff’s generous support of The Mount today is an example of Mr. Pigott’s continued legacy.

Presiding at the Mass was The Very Reverend Paul Magnano. Father Magnano spoke of how Providence Mount St. Vincent identifies its work as a ministry,

embracing its responsibility to provide for the needs of the elderly. He noted that the Catholic Church is the largest provider of health care services in the world

with over 16,000 homes for the elderly and over 5,500 hospitals worldwide.

A special musical tribute to Mrs. Wyckoff was composed and performed by Mateo Messina on piano and accompanied by The Covenant Quartet. Throughout his lifetime Mateo visited many Sisters of Providence while his mother worked at The Mount and where she now receives care.

Closing remarks were made by Concelebrant Reverend Stephen V. Sundborg, SJ.

Many people commented that they felt a powerful presence of spirit throughout the beautiful mass.

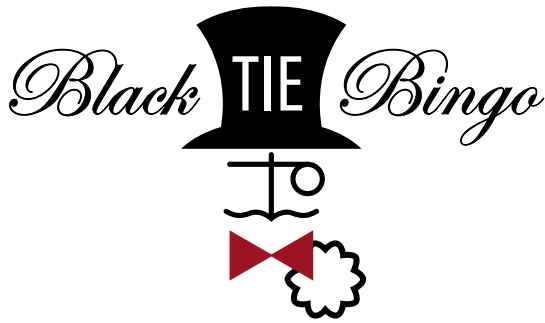

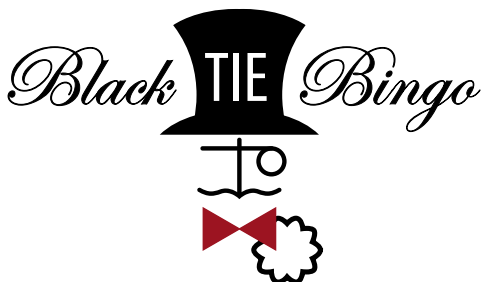
