THE CORE FUND

CORE is a collaborative approach that removes barriers to help families escape the traps of poverty. Donors to the CORE Fund are committed to making our community a better place for all its residents. When you invest in CORE, you are supporting a new approach to solving poverty. Rather than meeting one need that a child may have today, you are helping whole families find success every day and for generations to come. UWSC invites you to join them and invest in something different.

*Directing Your United Way Gift to a Nonprofit: If an agency you designate is not a qualified 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization, if the information is incomplete or if your designation is less than \$100, your gift will be re-directed to the CORE Fund. In addition, your agency must comply with the USA Patriot Act. Donations to nonprofit agencies, less an administrative fee of 19.4%, are paid based on what we receive and then disbursed quarterly. The maximum fee is \$250 per gift. No administrative fee is charged on donations to any United Way in Washington state.
